Short Biography Chien-Hui Lin is a Distinguished Professor of Special Education at the National Changhua University of Education (NCUE) and the Dean of the College of Education at NCUE. She is a member and an executive director of the Special Education Association of the Republic of China (SEAROC). Dr. Lin received her Ph.D. in 1991 from Lehigh University, Pennsylvania, U.S.A. Prior to her PhD, Dr. Lin was an associate researcher at Taiwan Provincial In-service Center for Elementary School Teachers, involved in the development of curriculum and teaching reform. Following an appointment as an Associate Professor in the Department of Special Education at NCUE, Dr. Lin served as the director of the Teaching Excellence Center in 2008, and the chair of the Department of Special Education from 2009 to 2011. Her areas of specialization including curriculum and teaching for students with intellectual disability, applied behavior analysis, as well as sexuality and relationship education for students with disability. Dr. Lin's professional performance has received numerous awards including the National Excellent Teacher Award from the Ministry of Education in 2016. Dr. Lin has a strong passion for pre-service and in-service teacher preparation in the field of special education and served actively as an advisory professor in many counties in central Taiwan.
